



Vidden Hike



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Details

The hike between Mount Ulriken and Mount Fløyen is one of the most popular hikes in Bergen with beautiful views of Bergen and the region.

The Vidden hike offers some of the best views of all the city mountains in Bergen. If you walk it on a clear day you can see all the way to Folgefonna glacier. The hike is doable in both directions, but this map shows the hike from Ulriken to Fløyen. If you follow this route you will have less elevation during your hike because Ulriken is higher above sea level than Fløyen. The hike is about 5 hours from the top of Ulriken to the top of Fløyen. The time estimated by the map is unfortunately wrong. You can read more about the hike [here](#).

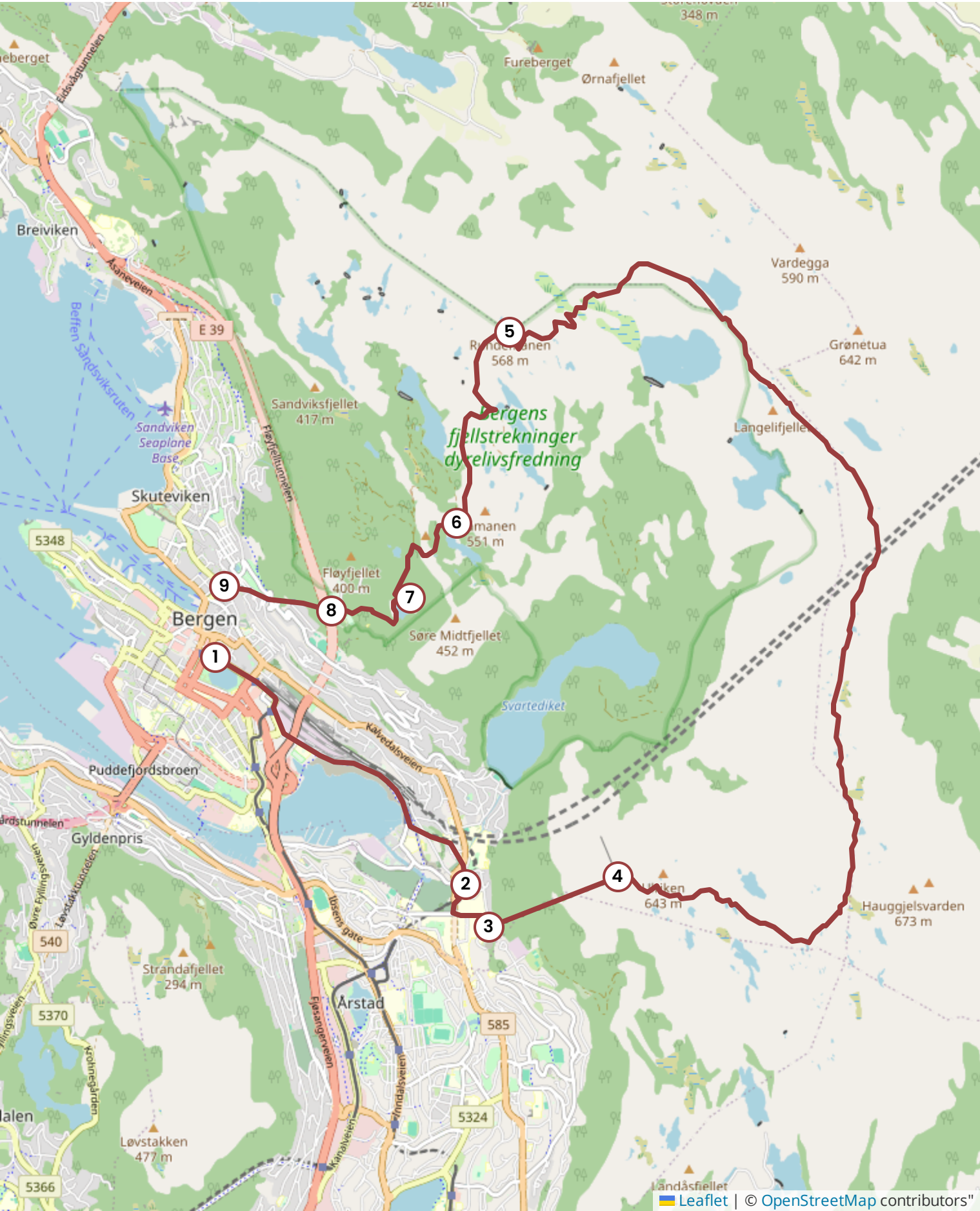
Vidden Hike

- In a large part of the city mountains it is forbidden to swim or camp. The blue areas [on this map](#) are the areas where camping and swimming is prohibited.
- Remember to keep your dog on a leash at all times.
- There is a general ban from making campfires from 15. april to 15. september.

We do not recommend that inexperienced hike Vidden during the winter months. The weather can be very unpredictable and the hours of daylight are few. Your last opportunity to use a toilet is by the upper station of Ulriken or Brushytten, depending on which way you hike. Between Ulriken and Brushytten there are no toilet opportunities.

Take the Bergen light rail line 2 from Kaigaten to Haukeland.

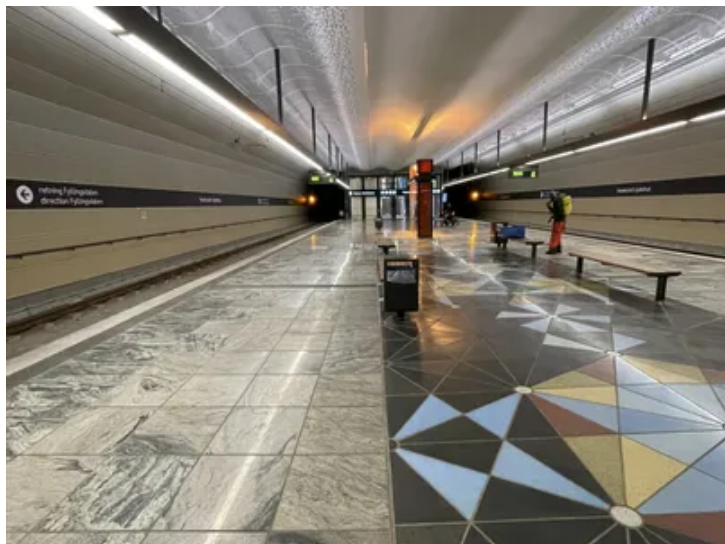

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2 Bybanen (Bergen Light Rail): stop Haukeland

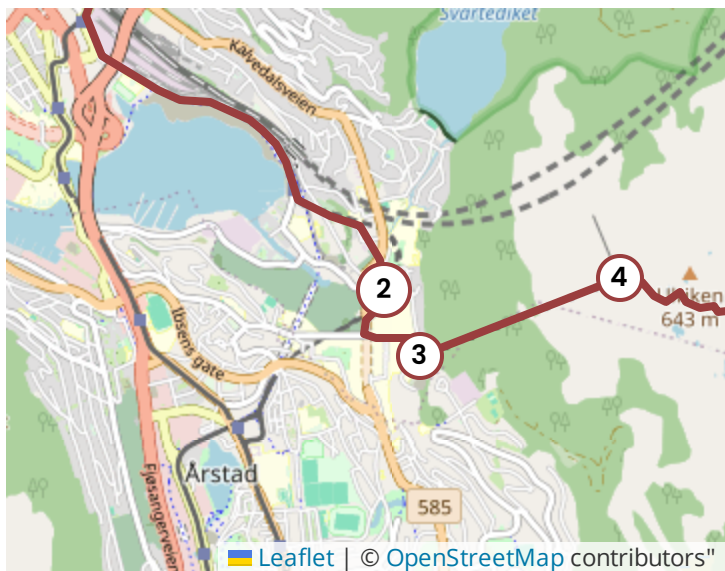
Get off the Bybanen (Bergen Light Rail) at Haukeland. From here you will walk to Ulriksbanen.

At Haukeland, use the exit called Haukeland. When outside, walk up the stairs on your left hand side. Follow the road uphill for 10-15 minutes until you have reached Ulriken Cable Car.



Arrive via Train from Bergen Light Rail (Bybanen) line 2

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3 Ulriken Cable Car lower station



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If you follow the route of this map you are going to take the Ulriken Cable car to the top of Ulriken. It is also possible to hike up, for information about hiking click [here](#).

Arrive via Hike from Bybanen (Bergen Light Rail): stop Haukeland
679 m / 0.42 mi - 15 minutes



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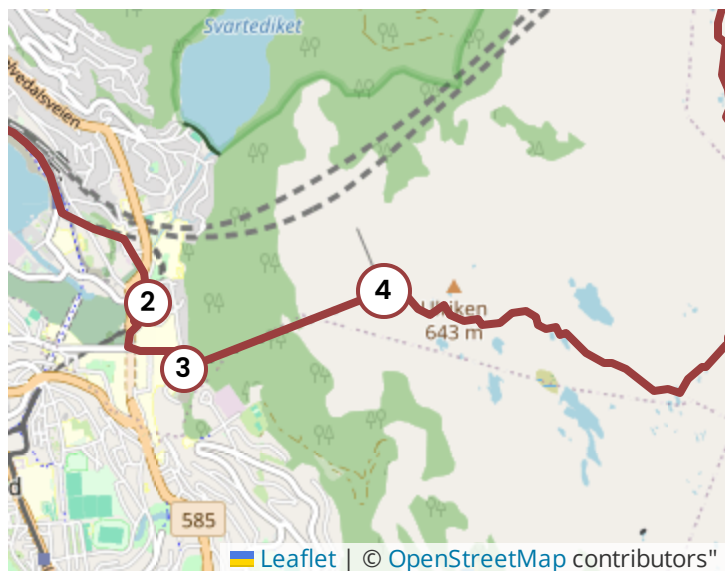
4 Ulriken Cable Car upper station

On the top of Mount Ulriken you will find a restaurant, café and toilet facilities.



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When you have reached the top of Ulriken you will find [Skyskraperen Restaurant](#) and [Ulriken café](#). Here are also the last available toilets before your five hour hike.



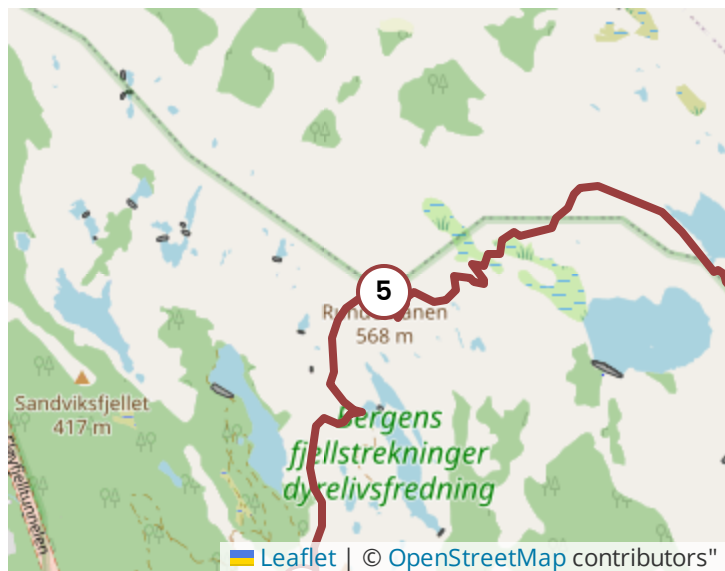
Arrive via Gondola from Ulriken Cable Car lower station

5 Mount Rundemanen

Mount Rundemanen is one of the seven city mountains in Bergen. If you hike up you can say that you have hiked three of the seven mountains!



Arrive via Hike from **Ulriken Cable Car upper station**
9.56 km / 5.94 mi - 2 hours 40 minutes



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6 Brushytten

The next stop on the route is Brushytten. Brushytten is a café/kiosk with toilet facilities.



Stop at Brushytten for a nice break on your hike, but be aware of the opening hours. You can find the opening hours and more information [here](#). (Normally only open on Sundays from 11:00 - 16:00)



Arrive via Hike from Mount Rundemanen
1.96 km / 1.22 mi - 28 minutes



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7 Skomakerstuen

Another nice café to stop by is Skomakerstuen.

Skomakerstuen is open between 11:00 and 16:00 on Saturdays and Sundays, and is a great stop to have a coffee and something sweet. During the summer it is also possible to go canoeing on the lake Skomakerdiket. Read more about canoeing [here](#).



Arrive via Hike from Brushytten
1.12 km / 0.69 mi - 17 minutes



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8 Fløibanen upper station


By the upper station of Fløibanen you have an amazing view over Bergen city center, as well as a restaurant, café, playground and toilets.



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On the top of Mount Fløyen you can get something to eat and drink. You have deserved it after your long hike! There is also a large playground if you are hiking with children. You can read more about the facilities on Fløyen [here](#). The last part of your hike is to take the Fløibanen funicular down to the city center. Tickets to the funicular are available [here](#). 825 m / 0.51 mi - 12 minutes



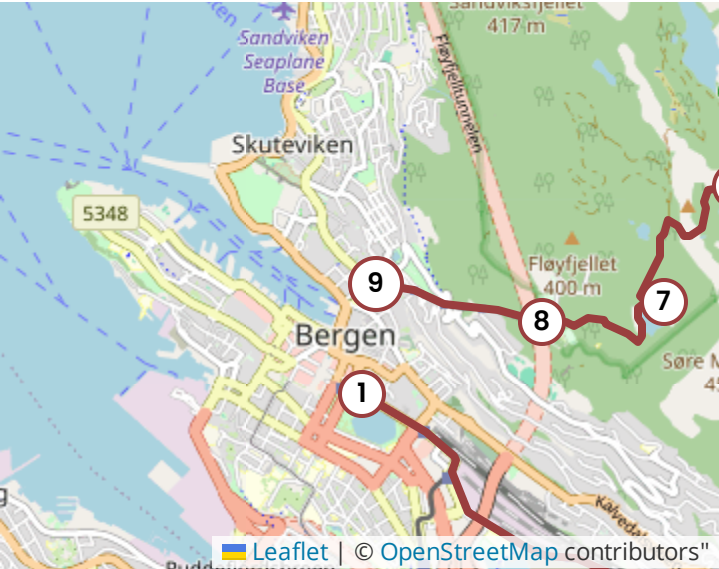
9 Fløibanen lower station

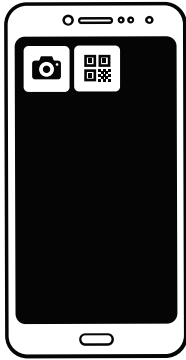

 Arrive via Funicular from Fløibanen upper station



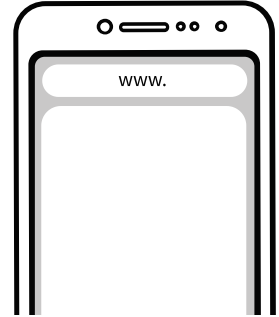
